

SPRING CITY SCHOLARSHIP AMBASSADOR PROGRAM RULES

Rules for this program are determined by the Spring City Scholarship Program Committee in conjunction with the Spring City Chamber of Commerce and are not dependent upon the rules & guidelines for any other program at any level. These rules have been formulated by the Program Committee and endorsed by the Spring City Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.

PARTICIPANTS: All participants in the Spring City Scholarship Program must meet all the following eligibility requirements..

1. Participants must live in the Spring City area, and be zoned to attend a Spring City School.
2. Participants in the Ambassador division must be a male (*recognized medically and legally as male in the United States*), and never been married, does not vape, smoke, drink, drug use, or have a police record.
3. The Ambassador Program will be open to Juniors and Seniors in high school. First place scholarship is \$1000, and second place scholarship is \$500. Each participant will be required to complete the application form, and return it with a \$10 entry fee, the essay, and letter of recommendation to the Chamber of Commerce by February 27th. You must also see your schools guidance counselor so they can send your GPA transcript to our office. Chamber hours are 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday - Thursday. Applications are available at the Spring City Chamber of Commerce Office as well as on the Chamber of Commerce Website and at RCHS Guidance Department. Failure in any of these provisions renders the applicant ineligible. Applications may be (1) mailed to P.O. Box 355 in time to be received before March 21st (2) placed in the drop box on the Chamber sign by the door.
Deadline to return the application to the Spring City Chamber of Commerce is February 27th.
4. **MANDATORY INTERVIEWS:**
You will be contacted for your interview between March 2nd and March 4th. Failure to complete the interview process will disqualify you from the winner selection. Participants must wear a black t-shirt and jeans for interview.
5. Winner will be announced on March 7th during the intermission of our Scholarship Program. Must be present to win. Attire will be business casual for award presentation.
6. Scholarship will be sent directly to the school of choice of the winner. Must be a College or technical school.

CONDUCT: We expect all program participants and aides to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with good taste and decorum. Anyone who fails to act in an acceptable manner will be disqualified and asked to leave the premises. This includes any participant whose aide is behaving in an unacceptable manner, regardless of the participant's own conduct.

DISQUALIFICATION: Any participant who is proven to have violated the rules of eligibility will be disqualified. Even after being named Ambassador the title and all accompanying accoutrements will be retrieved. The next person in line will move up until we have an eligible winner and runners-up.
