SPRING CITY SCHOLARSHIP PAGEANT RULES
SATURDAY, MARCH 24, 2012

The rules for this pageant are determined by the Spring City Scholarship Pageant Committee in conjunction with the Spring City Chamber of Commerce and are not dependent upon the rules and guidelines for any other pageant at any level. These rules have been formulated by the Pageant Committee and endorsed by the Spring City Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.

PARTICIPANTS: All participants in the Miss Spring City Pageant must meet all the following eligibility requirements.

1. Participants must be under 19 years of age as of pageant day and must verify age when turning in completed application.
2. Participants must live in the Spring City area, have a Spring City address or be zoned to attend a Spring City School.
2. Participants must have never been married and must not have borne a child.
3. Participants must compete in their appropriate age group based on age on Pageant Day.

Tiny Miss Spring City: age 0 through 18 months

Wee Miss Spring City: age 19 months through 2 years

Tot Miss Spring City: age 3 years—5 years

Little Miss Spring City: age 6 years—9 years (participation trophies)

Young Miss Spring City: age 10 years—12 years (\$50 cash awarded)

Junior Miss Spring City: age 13 years—15 years (\$100 cash awarded)

Miss Spring City: age 16 years—18 years (\$1,000 College Scholarships Awarded)

All age groups will award Winner, 1st & 2nd runner-up if more than 4 contestants in group. Gift bags to everyone 5 yrs. & under.

4. Eligible females must compete in their specific age category.
5. Each participant is limited to one chaperone/escort/aide to help him or her prepare for the pageant, at no additional cost. For the youngest participants, we suggest the person who will put the child most at ease. The aide may be a parent, but does not have to be. Each participant will be expected to present herself to the judges. The aid will present babies in Tiny & Wee categories only. No presentation, no score.
6. Each participant will be required to obtain an application form, complete the form, and return it with the appropriate entry fee by the established deadline. Failure in any of these provisions renders the applicant ineligible, regardless of residence or age eligibility. **Deadline to return the application is Thursday, March 15.** They may be turned in at the Spring City Chamber of Commerce office in the Depot or mailed to P.O. Box 362. Must be received by March 15. Entry fee is **\$40** per application. Application fees are non-refundable. Contestants will be presented on stage in reverse order of applications received. If you wish to be judged toward the end of your group, you must get in your application early.

DRESS: Appropriate attire for the pageant participants is as follows:

1. Tiny, Wee, Tot, and Little Miss divisions may wear Pageant or suitable Church attire.
2. Young and Junior Miss divisions may wear either short or long Pageant attire.
3. Miss Spring City Contestants may wear either short or long Pageant attire.

CONDUCT: We expect all pageant participants and aides to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with good taste and decorum. Anyone who fails to act in an acceptable manner will be disqualified and asked to leave the premises of the pageant. This includes any participant whose aide is behaving in an unacceptable manner, regardless of the participant's own conduct.

DISQUALIFICATION: Any participant who is proven to have violated the rules of eligibility will be disqualified. Even after being crowned as Miss Spring City in any category, or as one of the runners-up, the title and all accompanying accoutrements will be retrieved. The next person in line will move up until we have an eligible winner and runners-up.

Miss Spring City Contestants (age 16-18) are required to attend the practice. Failure to attend may render participant ineligible. You will learn the routine for stage appearance, and receive a copy of the Judge's Score sheet. Mandatory interviews will be Saturday afternoon. 2012 Miss Spring City will represent Spring City at all Chamber Events, local parades and may be invited to other events to represent Spring City during her reign.

All contestants are expected to participate in the rehearsal on Friday, March 23 at 5:30 to learn and understand what is expected of contestants on pageant night. You will then receive a copy of the Judge's Score Sheet. Failure to attend rehearsals will not render younger participants ineligible, but could potentially affect your score. First 3 divisions will be judged Saturday morning, March 24. Last 4 divisions will be judged Saturday evening. **Failure to check in 30 minutes prior to the appropriate age group being presented may be grounds for rendering a participant ineligible. Pick up contestants number at the door when you arrive at practice and on pageant day.**
